Welcome Back: The first day of school for 7-12 students will be on Monday, August 18, 2014. School will start at 8:00am and end at 3:44pm K-6 students will NOT start school on Monday, August, 18th. There will be an Elementary Orientation from 9:30am to 3:00pm on Monday, August 18th for parents to bring their K-6 Child(ren) in and meet the teacher and bring supplies. Lunch will not be served to K-6 students and busses will not pick up K-6 students. K-6 students first day of school will be Tuesday, August 19, 2013. Regular school hours for 7-12 will be 8:00am to 3:44pm, Monday through Thursday. Friday dismissals will be at 2:40pm.

School Lunch Program: Lunch will be served on the first day of school. Each Student/Staff will have a 4 digit lunch code that they will need to know in order to go through the lunch line.

Lunch prices for the 2014-2015 school year will be K-6 \$2.30 or \$46.00 for 20 meals, 7-12 \$2.45 or \$49.00 for 20 meals and Adults \$3.65. Breakfast price \$1.95. An extra carton of milk will be \$.45. Seconds for 7-12 will cost an additional \$.35. Parents with Kindergarten and First grade students will be charged an additional \$3.00 per month for snacks.

Lunch charges will not be accepted. Payment for lunches must be made in advance. YOUR LUNCH ACCOUNT NEEDS TO BE PAID MONTHLY. IF YOU NEED TO MAKE OTHER ARRANGEMENTS, PLEASE CALL THE SCHOOL OFFICE AT 836-2273.

If you did not receive an application or have questions filling out the application, please call the school at 836-2273. Families may apply any time during the school year. As required by law, all information is completely confidential.

Student Handbook: Both parents and all students in the family who are in school, should sign the form included with the handbook and RETURN THE SIGNED FORM TO THE SCHOOL BY MONDAY, AUGUST 25th.

School Insurance: Students will be also be receiving insurance forms the first day of school explaining the 24-hour, school-time, dental, life, and football coverage. If you would like to be covered under this policy, please return the application with the premium money to the school office. Coverage starts on the day your check is received at the school. All checks must be made out to: Student Assurance Services, Inc., The WAIVER FORM needs to be returned to the school by FRIDAY, AUGUST 25th, if you are not planning on using the insurance coverage.

Bus Notes: Students not on regular routes who will be riding the bus, students transported to another stop, or town students wishing to use the school transportation must turn in a written note, from their parent or guardian, to the office to be approved prior to the time transportation is needed. Students, who do not have a note, will not be able to ride. This is in compliance with state law and school policy

Locked Doors: For the Safety of the students, the School Board decided to leave all doors locked during the school day expect the office doors on the west side of the building. All visitors are required to check in at the office.

Activity Passes: Activity passes will be available for the 2013-2014 sports season. The cost will be as follows: K-12 students - \$20.00, Adults - \$40.00 and Family - \$80.00. The pass will admit you to all Callaway/Arnold HOME Volleyball, Football, and Basketball games. The pass will not be good for any tournament games. Regular admission for sport activities for Students will be \$3.00 and Adults will be \$5.00. Senior citizen passes are also available free of charge. Please call the school office at 836-2273.

Asbestos in the School: This notice is being written to inform you that our school district does have a limited amount of asbestos. The asbestos is located in the Jr.-Sr. High school and in the elementary building as well. The asbestos is located on thermal pipe elbows and thermal pipe joints in the gym and the locker room areas. The hot water holding tank in the boiler room has a covering that contains asbestos. All the areas mentioned are covered and in good shape. The building has been inspected and a management plan to contain or remove the asbestos has been developed and sent to the Nebraska Department of Health. The school district will go through another inspection this year to determine the condition of the asbestos as to this date. If you should have more questions concerning the asbestos plan, please feel free to discuss your concerns with the Superintendent. The asbestos management plan is located in the central office.

Student Absences: To help insure the safety of the students, we are asking all parents, to please call the school office when he/she will be absent. This will minimize time if something were to happen to the student on their way to school. We appreciate your cooperation.

Lost and Found: Throughout the year we get an accumulation of clothes, shoes, coats, jewelry, house keys, etc. If your child has lost or misplaced anything, please check at the main office or at the athletic office. Parents, it would also help if you put your child's name on clothing, especially coats, as we end up with an assortment at the end of the year. Any item not claimed at the end of the year, will be taken to Goodwill.

ELEMENTARY OPEN HOUSE

They will be dismissed to assigned rooms for class meetings. Students will follow a shortened schedule after their class meetings. Breakfast and lunch will be served.

Jr. High students and parents will participate in the meetings but will not be able to take their computers home until a later date. Mr. Keeney is doing this to allow the staff time to get going with the high school before we throw the Jr. into the mix.
