

Callaway Public Schools ARP ESSER III Use of Funds Plan

Callaway Public Schools (CPS) has been awarded \$203,471 in ARP ESSER III funds. CPS will utilize ESSER funding throughout 2021-2022 to the 2023-2024 school years. To account for the learning loss, CPS will use 45% of the ESSER III funds, or \$92,471, to accelerate learning, and account for learning loss.

The highest priority has been given to find the most effective way to use these funds for addressing learning loss among students, including academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students; including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and migratory students. Allocation to directly address learning loss- \$92,471

- Addressing learning loss among students, including academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs.
- \$92,471 will be used to add staff to address learning loss attributed to lost academic time due to COVID-19.

Allocation to address air quality within The Callaway Public Schools Building- \$111,000

- Callaway Public Schools is updating its HVAC and air handling unites throughout the facility. \$111,000 will be used to offset the total cost of the project.
